WHITE WINE

- 1. FONTE DE NICO VINHO BRANCO** 18.95
PORTUGAL 175ml Glass 4.60
250ml Glass 6.50
Light and fresh, yet soft on the palate with ripe citrus fruits and good minerality.
- 2. DOMINIO DE LA FUENTE VERDEJO, ORGANIC** 20.50
SPAIN 175ml Glass 5.10
250ml Glass 7.20
A crisp, aromatic white, showing great purity of aromas with intense, fresh notes of grass, fennel and white pepper on the palate.
- 3. SAN GIORGIO PINOT GRIGIO** 22.50
ITALY 175ml Glass 5.40
250ml Glass 7.60
A crisp white with invigorating citrus fruit. Honeysuckle meets pear drop notes for a balanced palate.
- 4. SAUVIGNON BLANC RESERVA, TERRA VEGA** 24.50
CHILE 175ml Glass 5.85
250ml Glass 8.30
A pronounced and herbaceous bouquet of green pepper and gooseberry accompanies subtle hints of passion fruit.
- 5. PICPOUL PLO D'ISABELLE, PICPOUL DE PINET** 27.25
SOUTH OF FRANCE 175ml Glass 6.75
250ml Glass 9.40
A snappy nose of lemon and lime fruit with vibrant green apple. A racy wine with a lip-tingling finish.
- 6. L'ETOILE DE BEGUDE CHARDONNAY** 33.50
LIMOUX, FRANCE
This relatively cool climate Chardonnay is crisp and aromatic with characteristics to rival fine Burgundies, but at a significantly more palatable price.
- 7. SAINT CLAIR PIONEER BLOCK SAUVIGNON BLANC** 37.00
MARLBOROUGH, NEW ZEALAND
An intensity of fruit, with aromas of gooseberry and passionfruit, plus a steely dryness and underlying minerality.

ROSÉ

- 8. PINOT GRIGIO ROSÉ LE COLLINE DI SAN GIORGIO** 23.95
ITALY 175ml Glass 5.75
250ml Glass 8.20
Fresh apricot and peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate and a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish.
- 9. HAUT VOL ROSÉ** 26.50
SOUTH OF FRANCE 175ml Glass 6.50
250ml Glass 8.90
Light-bodied and delicately fruity characterised by the sweet summer smells of strawberries and raspberries.
- 10. CHÂTEAU DE BERNE ROSÉ** 33.50
CÔTES DE PROVENCE, FRANCE
Elegant and characterful with lively, intense notes of citrus and stone fruits and a smooth hint of sweet oak.

RED WINE

- 11. FONTE DO NICO VINHO TINTO** 18.95
PORTUGAL 175ml Glass 4.60
250ml Glass 6.50
With aromas of fresh berries, this wine is soft in the mouth, with good quality tannin structure and a pleasant finish.
- 12. FIVE RAVENS PINOT NOIR** 22.50
ROMANIA 175ml Glass 5.40
250ml Glass 7.60
From a little off the beaten track, this Pinot Noir all the classic bright red fruit flavours and spicy notes you would expect.
- 13. PAVILLION DES TROIS ARCHES MERLOT** 24.50
SOUTH OF FRANCE 175ml Glass 5.85
250ml Glass 8.30
Richly flavoured, packed full of plump cherry and cedar notes. Ripe and generous tannins tie this wine together.
- 14. MOZZAFIATO PRIMITIVO** 24.50
ITALY 175ml Glass 5.85
250ml Glass 8.30
Flavours of dried prune, date and plump cherry, with swathes of sweet spice. A mouth coating, chocolatey red wine.
- 15. CAPILLA DE BARRO MALBEC, MENDOZA** 24.50
ARGENTINA 175ml Glass 5.85
250ml Glass 8.30
An intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate, delivering a wave of ripe, fresh black fruit and mocha.
- 16. RIOJA RESERVA, BARÓN DE EBRO** 27.25
SPAIN 175ml Glass 6.75
250ml Glass 9.40
Exhibiting luscious bramble fruit, partnered with a spicy complexity, herbaceous notes and flavours of liquorice.
- 17. CH STE MICHELLE CABERNET SAUVIGNON** 34.00
WASHINGTON, USA
From Washington's oldest winery, this wine is packed with blackcurrant and blackberry, notes of cedar and vanilla follow on to a silky smooth finish.
- 18. BAROLO ARALDICA** 42.00
ITALY
This lovely ruby coloured wine exhibits aromas of plums, leather and violets. The palate is rich with red fruits, spice and a hint of smoke. The finish is long and complex.
- 19. CHATEAU BATAILLEY, PAUILLAC** 68.00
BORDEAUX, FRANCE
Nestled in Pauillac, France's fine-wine oasis, Château Batailley was honoured in the legendary Bordeaux 1855 Classification as a 'Fifth Growth'. A complex mix of briar fruit, cassis, leather and earth.

SPARKLING & CHAMPAGNE

- 20. PROSECCO ROMEO AND JULIET** 27.50
ITALY 125ml Glass 6.00
Lightly aromatic with a soft fizz and an off-dry feel. Flavours of pear, clementine and white apple are lifted by soft acidity.
- 21. VEUVE CLICQUOT BRUT NV** 68.50
CHAMPAGNE, FRANCE
Veuve Clicquot ages their non-vintage for almost twice the required time, resulting in a superb marriage of freshness and power.
